## Rescheduled Exciting Hemi Hideout Trip! Friday, May 10

**The Hemi Hideout, named for the hemispherical shape of powerful engines, sits on 110 acres of lushly landscaped grounds. The barn-like museum was inspired by a picture of an old Colorado barn and is the largest structure in Texas. The rugged beams of the vast museum support more than 1200 enamel and porcelain signs from oil companies, gas stations, car dealerships and others, dating back to the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. The 24 meticulously restored Mopar cars will blow your mind. The bus will leave at 8:30 AM for a 9:30 AM arrival in Brookshire. Enjoy the tour, the cars, the signs, the building and the beautiful setting. We will have lunch at Midway BBQ and return to the church between 2:30 and 3 PM. Cost is \$15.**
