

# FIREHOUSE NO. 7 MUSEUM – SEPTEMBER 17

The construction of Firehouse NO. 7 was completed and opened in 1899. Houston's oldest remaining firehouse, it was still in use until 1968. Now renovated and reopened as a museum on the historic registry, 50+ will get a glimpse into Houston's Fire Department history with a guided tour. There will be time to explore on your own and treat yourself to the gift shop, too. This event will also include a stop at a 50 + favorite, the Cleburne Cafeteria.
